

ADOPT A SENIOR GREYHOUND



Here are Irish greyhounds Phoebe and Jenny. Both were imported from Ireland as seniors, graduated from the prison program and have been adopted.

In our adoption program, the greyhounds that are the nicest, yet the most difficult to find homes for are the seniors. We consider a greyhound to be a senior after they reach the age of 7 years. Senior greyhounds come to us mainly from adoptive homes that have adopted these dogs when they were young, but have to give them up after a few years for a variety of reasons. These returned pets are already home acclimated, are normally in good to excellent condition, and will settle right into their new home environment. The families that give them up have the peace of mind of knowing that we will find them a new home and will love and take care of them until that time.

Some of the Irish greyhounds are also older when they come to us. These greyhounds may not have had adopters in Ireland, have raced a long time, or raised litters of pups before they were available for adoption. They are normally sweet and gentle, some are already used to living in a home, and are an excellent pet. Also, we have reduced the adoption fee for the senior greyhounds.

Please do not forget the senior greyhounds. They need us most of all.
